- in the early part of his or her career, having made a recent significant, original contribution to the field, and
- for outstanding work in the accelerator field with no age limit.

The recipients will receive a certificate and a cash prize, which will be presented during a public ceremony at EPAC'98. They will also be invited to make an oral presentation of the work which earned them the prize and to submit their contributions for publication in the Conference Proceedings. This Nomination Form, together with supporting documentation (brief curriculum vitae for an individual applicant, brief group history and structure for a group application, list of relevant publications with copies of up to three of the most significant, and letters of reference from one or more Proposers justifying the nomination, etc.), must reach the EPAC Executive Secretary by the deadline of **5 December 1997**. When possible, please invite an individual from an external institution to act as a Proposer.
