### Description of Submission:

Title of the Paper Type in the Title of the Paper (first letter of each main word capitalized)

Authors & Affiliations: Authors names to be typed in capital letters, in alphabetical order and grouped by affiliation (i.e. A. AUTHOR, B. AUTHOR, C. AUTHOR, CERN; A. AUTHOR, B. AUTHOR, C. AUTHOR, DESY)  
References to the title or authors should be indicated by "\*", "\*\*", etc.

Text of Abstract: Type the text of the abstract in one continuous paragraph (maximum of 200 words). Use [1], [2] etc. to identify footnotes.

References: Describe references with "\*", "\*\*", etc. separated by carriage returns

Footnotes: List footnotes using [1], [2], etc. separated by carriage returns

Presentation Option: Indicate clearly one of the following presentation options: Oral, Poster, Poster only/no publication, No Choice

Classification: Indicate the classification of the paper (according to the classification list available on the Web, or included in the 1st Announcement).

Papers presented at PAC'95, EPAC'96[1] and PAC'97 have been published on WWW and on CD-ROM. This new publication method requires special care on the part of authors and more work in the preparation of the final document for the editorial team. Experience has highlighted the need to give more help to authors with the preparation of their papers, particularly for the inclusion of graphics and use of fonts. The majority of the time after receipt of the postscript files is spent fixing problems which either prevent the postscript file from passing through the software or which result in poor quality in the final document. This paper summarises the difficulties encountered and suggests improvements in the methods and procedures to be implemented for EPAC'98.
